ABSENCE FOR COLLEGE VISITS

WSSD believes in the importance of regular school attendance during the entire school year. Consistent attendance is required to reap the benefits of all of the educational opportunities offered by the school district. Students are urged to visit colleges prior to their senior year on the weekend if at all possible to avoid the loss of valuable classroom instruction.

If a college visit is made during a school day(s) this form must be completed by parents/guardians at least **3 days** prior to the visit & submitted to the Attendance Office.

The student may make up work missed during the absence, **if excused**. Any work assigned and not made up may receive a zero by the teacher(s).

Any previously assigned work (including projects, term papers & major assignments) that are due during the absence must be turned into the teacher **BEFORE** the college visit.

The maximum amount of visits per school year is 3 & may only be taken by juniors and seniors.

College visits will be approved for students who are in good academic, disciplinary, and attendance standing.

Students that are not in good standing or who have already gone on 3 visits will need approval from an administrator
