The **SAFETY & SECURITY COORDINATOR** is the District's chief security officer responsible, per ACT 44 of 2018 for the physical safety of faculty, students, and staff across five schools and two standalone offices. Reporting directly to the Superintendent of Schools, the Safety & Security Coordinator also performs supervisory and administrative tasks in developing, implementing, and managing security compliance programs. Additionally, the Coordinator serves as the primary point of contact for emergency communications with schools, community, and emergency responders in addition to designing plans to mitigate manmade and natural threats such as severe weather or fires.
